Alcohol Use Policy

YMCA Point Bonita Outdoor & Conference Center is committed to providing a safe, comfortable environment for all of our guests. In this spirit, the YMCA will allow some alcohol consumption at YMCA Point Bonita in accordance with the following Alcohol Use Policy.

- 1. Alcohol is not allowed during Outdoor Education and related youth programs administered by the YMCA Point Bonita.
2. Only Conference groups that are not sharing the campus with other groups may serve alcohol. Typically this means that the group has an "exclusive use" provision in its contract, although the YMCA can grant an exception for a group that coincidentally is not sharing the campus with other groups.
3. The group must provide YMCA Point Bonita with proof of liquor liability insurance coverage for its event, and shall obtain an additional named insured endorsement naming the YMCA of San Francisco for the event.
4. The safe and appropriate behavior of guests is the responsibility of the group that is visiting the YMCA. It is the responsibility of the group to enforce compliance with relevant local, state, and Federal laws, as well as policies of the YMCA Point Bonita. The contracting group's leader is responsible to advise guests of responsible, safe behavior, and enforce same.
5. If guests under the age of 21 are present for the event or conference, each minor's parent or guardian must also be present.
6. The responsible consumption of alcohol is permitted for conference guests who are 21 years of age or older. Guests under the age of 21 may not acquire, possess, or consume alcohol. No one can provide alcohol to persons under age 21, nor permit any underage consumption. Guests under the age of 21 may not serve alcohol to others.
7. For groups serving alcohol only beer and wine may be served. Hard alcohol on site is prohibited.
8. Alcohol cannot be sold on YMCA premises; "no-host" bars are not allowed.
9. The YMCA will not serve or provide alcohol.
10. Guests must demonstrate respectful behavior towards other guests, YMCA staff, Park Service personnel, Park visitors, and YMCA and National Park Service property
11. To ensure safety and compliance, the YMCA reserves the right to clarify, limit, or addend this policy as circumstances dictate.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand this Alcohol Use Policy, and will take responsibility for my group's compliance with this policy. I acknowledge and agree that any violation will be reported to YMCA Point Bonita staff, and may result in the group's removal from the premises, referral to Park Police, and/or not being allowed to return to the YMCA Point Bonita.
