

**Presidio YMCA Adult Basketball Leagues
PLAYER CONDUCT AGREEMENT**

PERSONAL CONDUCT

Any player guilty of moral misbehavior (including but not limited to; any physical or verbal attacks on any player, official, staff member, or spectator), poor sportsmanship, or interference in any way adversely affecting the benefit the program offers to others, shall be disciplined either by restricting their playing privilege (game suspension), revoking their playing privilege (expulsion from league) in any current or future leagues and programs. Any player ejected during a game will not be eligible to participate in the team's next game (and possible multiple games). Team captains are responsible for the actions of their players.

FOUL LANGUAGE

Foul or abusive language will NOT be tolerated. Any player or spectator guilty of using foul language can receive a technical foul.

TECHNICAL FOULS

- Any team receiving three technical fouls in one game will receive an automatic forfeit and the game will be over.
- Any individual player receiving two technical fouls in one game will be ejected from that game and a minimum one game suspension.
- Any player ejected from the game must leave the facility within two minutes.
- Play will not resume until the ejected player has exited the facility.
- If any ejected player refuses to leave the gym within two minutes, the game will be forfeited by their team and that player will not be eligible to play for the remainder of the season.
- League fees will not be refunded.
- Any player receiving four technical fouls during the course of the season and/or playoffs will be suspended from league play for the remainder of the season, playoffs, and championship.
- A player under suspension is not allowed to enter the facility as a spectator.
- Players not honoring their suspension will be subject to law enforcement.
- Presidio YMCA Adult Basketball League management has the right to issue long term suspension or revoke playing privilege of any player at any time for acts deemed detrimental to the league.

DOCUMENTATION OF MISCONDUCT

Conduct deemed in violation of league code of conduct can be documented with the YMCA of San Francisco and proper authorities.

APPEALS

Appeals may be submitted to PresidioYABL@ymcasf.net within 24 hours of an incident.
